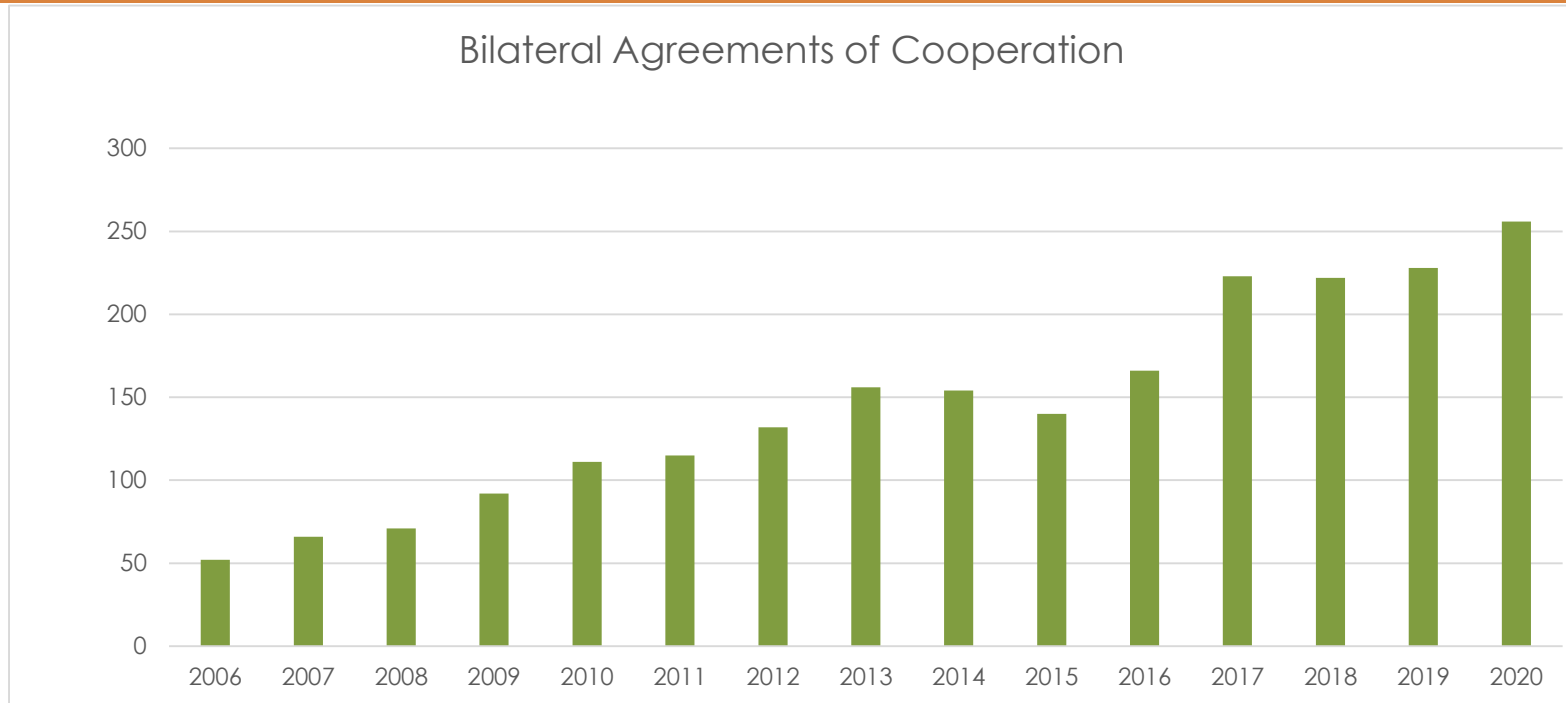

Students will have the opportunity to study in all the participating universities:

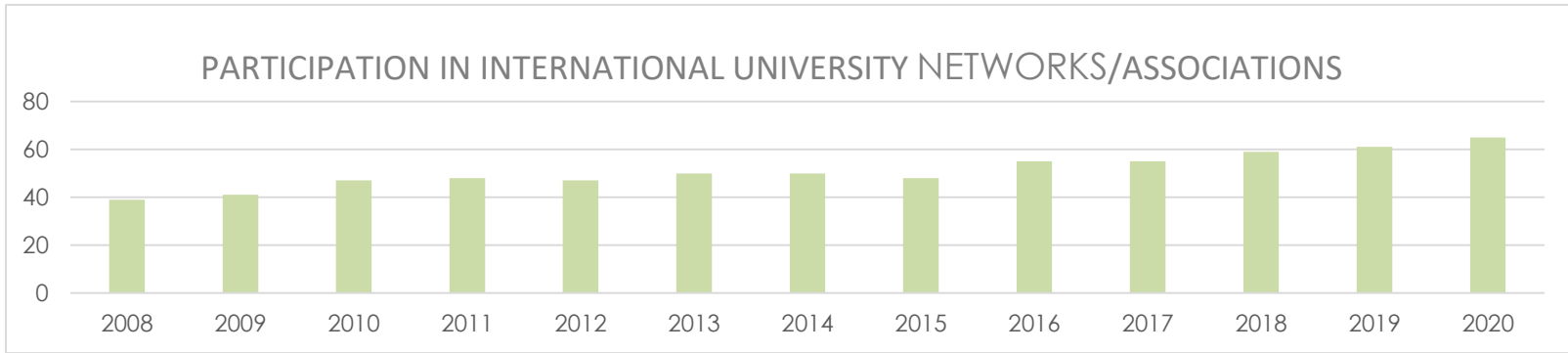

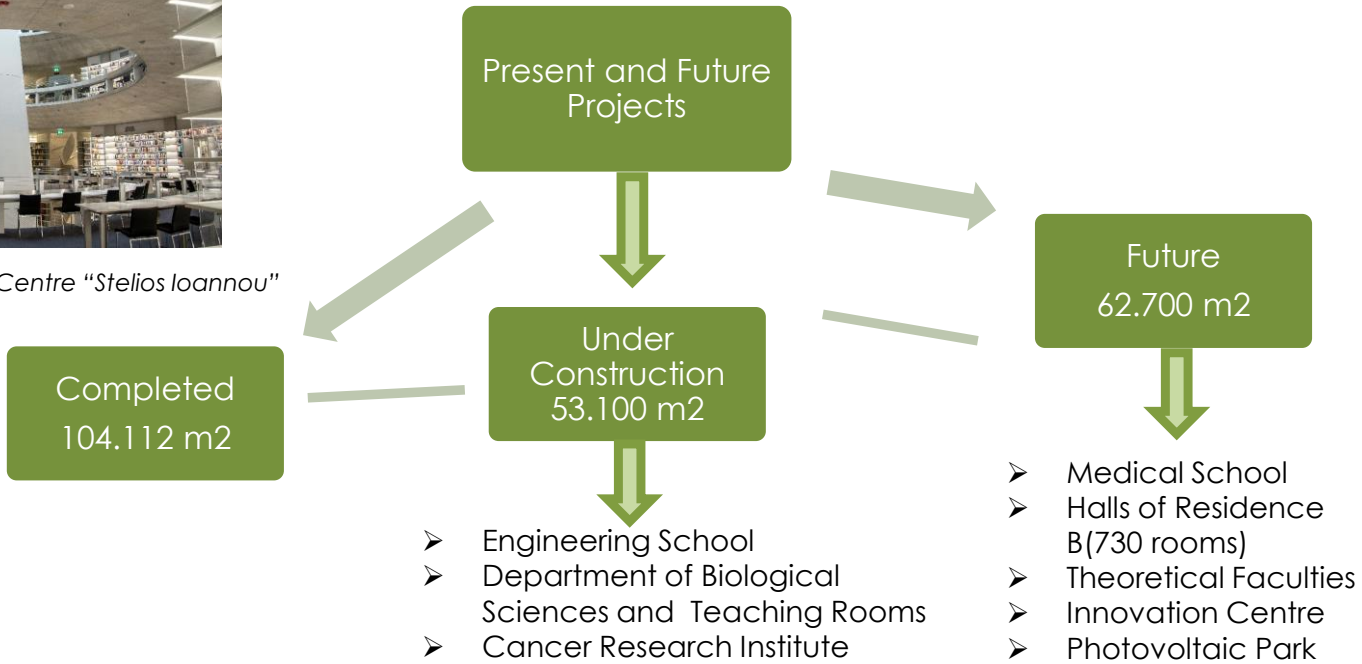
